♥ Preschool for All is a high quality, play-based program that brings together qualified staff, a proven curriculum, and parent involvement to help prepare children for success in school.

♥ There is no cost to parents for the Preschool for All program. The program is funded through a grant from the State of Illinois.

♥ Each half day class (morning and afternoon) is composed of one large, colorful classroom with 2 individual student bathrooms, & 2 certified teachers.

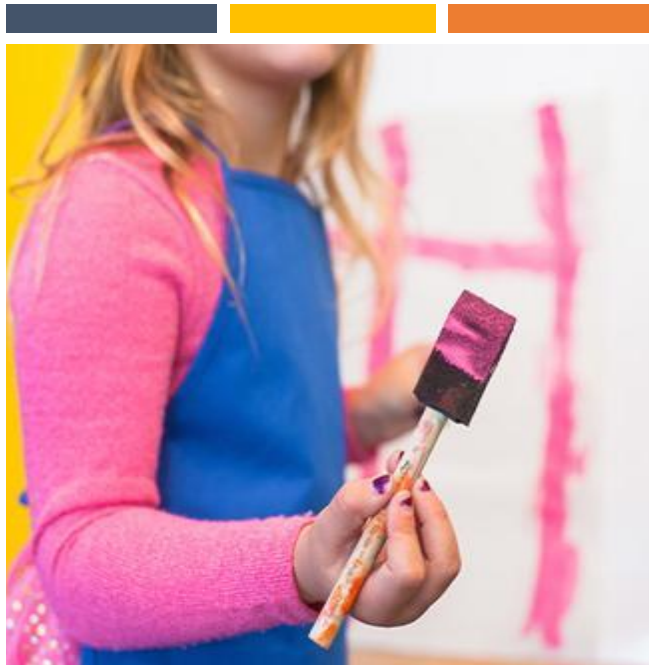
Preschool helps children develop the social, emotional, and pre-academic skills they need to succeed in school and in life.

Is my child ready for Preschool for All?

Yes! Preschool for All helps children develop the skills they need to succeed in school and later in life. Programs have been designed to meet the learning needs of children ages 3-5. Children are welcome to attend whether or not they are potty-trained.

How do I enroll my child?

Call Delavan School District at (309) 244-8283 to select a screening time for your child. After screening is complete, children are either accepted into the program or placed on a waiting list for an opening. Financial, academic, social, and other criteria are taken into consideration when prioritizing enrollment. However, these needs are not always present for all students.



Our Mission:

The mission of our Delavan PRESCHOOL FOR ALL program is:

to provide educational opportunities that encourage each child's physical, social, emotional, and intellectual growth while inspiring a lifelong commitment to learning.

Program includes:

- ♥ **SCHOOL SUPPLIES** necessary for your child to use in class. All that your child needs is a full-sized book bag.
- ♥ **A MEAL** is provided for each student during class time (breakfast for AM class & lunch for PM class).
- ♥ **FIELD TRIPS** are provided free of charge for students and an adult chaperone. If an in-person field trip cannot take place, a virtual field trip may be held through ZOOM.
- ♥ **FAMILY FUN EVENTS** are a way to get the whole family involved in the joy of learning! These events are also provided free of charge and may include a take home meal/snack for your family, crafts, games, activities, prizes, family entertainment, & more! If events cannot take place in-person, they will still be held virtually through ZOOM.
- ♥ **TRANSPORTATION** is available via small school bus home from morning preschool or to school for the afternoon preschool class. If you live outside of town, bus service is optional to and from school.
